

2024 Scholarships

General Information

All ages are invited to apply for a scholarship from the Guinea Heritage Association, Ltd. The GHA offers four scholarships: GHA, \$1,000; C.B. Rowe, \$1,000; Mac Sisson Technical/Vocational, \$1,000; and Kenneth A. Hall, \$5,000. Applications from prior winners are accepted.

Scholarship awards are sent directly to the college, technical school, or educational program in which the recipient is enrolled, upon verification of his/her enrollment. The award may be applied towards tuition, board, books, tools, other training equipment, etc. The recipient has one year from the date of award to use the scholarship. If not used within that timeframe, the scholarship will revert to the GHA.

Qualifications

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for any of the Scholarships:

- Minimum grade point average to be accepted at the applicant's chosen educational institution.
- Justified financial need.
- Family or personal association with the heritage of the Guinea area will be given priority

For the C.B. Rowe Memorial Scholarship, this **additional criteria** must be met:

- Residence from Hayes Store to Big Island
- Applicants **must** demonstrate a family or personal association with the heritage of Guinea.
